

Important Reminder

Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Medications...Are never to be sent to school with the student! Parents or an adult should bring medications to the office. Medications must have a doctor order accompanying it to be dispensed at school (even over-the-counter medications such as aspirin, cough med, etc.)

If your child is sick...Keep your child home if or when they have vomited or had diarrhea the night before or the morning of school, even if they say they feel better. Chances are it will last only for a short time. They should stay home at least 24 hours.

If fever... (Anything measured with a thermometer that is equal to or greater than 100 degrees F). Students are to be fever free for 24 hours without the aid of medication (Tylenol, ibuprofen, etc.).

Medical appointments... (Doctor, dentist, eye) Please get a note from that office to return to school, especially if the student has any restrictions for school.
